International Multi-Ethnic Cultural Center (Mission- Unity & Cultural Diversity)

Photographic Artist Gagnon along with his management team has a long-term goal of creating an International Multi-Ethnic Cultural Center. The geographical area of interest to house this center is St. Augustine, Florida because of its strong cultural overtones and that it is the oldest city in the United States. The cultural center will have a focus in the following areas:

- The Center will create partnerships with Epcot in Orlando, other cultural centers, museums and libraries as well as with governments.
- The purpose of the center is to unite all people of different cultures. The center will present the artwork of artists of varied cultural backgrounds. The center will attract artists from all over the world from the West, to the Middle East to the Far East. The main focus is that art has always been non-judgmental. All people, no matter what their particular political or belief persuasion has been, have on the most part accepted the art of all cultures.
- The center will promote peace and social change toward accepting other cultures through educational programs.
- The center will attract industrial leaders, prominent artists, promoters of peace, religious leaders, artists in the performing arts field, and political leaders as part of its Board of Trustees.
- The center will attract a committed group of Directors that are leaders in the community and believe in the goals of the center.
- The art considered at the center will be art in promoting beauty, symbolic in promoting social change toward unity and peace, and in promoting the heritage of all individual cultures.
- The center will be involved in some fundraising efforts to resolve problems in our society, whether they are domestic or foreign in nature. Some of these problems may involve natural disasters, poverty, educational concerns, etc.
