RE: Some Correctional Workers under orders of the Warden of the Bedford Correctional Facility

Per the request of Pamela Smart's mother Linda Wojas, I have replaced this letter with the letter that was sent to me from Pamela Smart. Within the last two years, Pamela Smart had been subjected to additional persecution within Bedford Correctional Facility. Because of my association with the Governor of NY, Honorable George Pataki, I requested that he look into that particular situation and it was resolved. The letter which Ms. Smart sent to me referenced the particular situation. Currently, I am working on a variety of art pieces concerning 9-11-01 and have pieces slated for the World Trade Center Memorial. I am in constant contact with the Honorable Governor as well as others in the NY State area.

The other reason why the Pamela Smart letter was on my website is that I am working on an art piece collage entitled *What of Justice?* which presents the injustices in our society. What is interesting is that the correctional officers in Bedford Correctional Facility are insisting that Pamela Smart's letter be taken off my website which is in violation of the First Amendment of the United States Constitution. I have discussed this with two attorneys, a friend of mine who is with the Department of Homeland Security, another with Florida State Government and another Federal Agent with the Treasury Department and all have advised me to do something about this.

Because of my relationship with the Governor of NY, they have advised me to set up a meeting with **Glenn S. Goord, Commissioner of the NYS Department of Correctional Services** who was appointed by Governor George Pataki. I also have been advised to bring Elizabeth Langevin, Program Planning and Evaluation of the NYS Department of Corrections into this situation. Because of my ties with the Sun Sentinel, WXEL, WLRN, the Miami Herald and several magazines as well as an Editor by the name of Helen Gurley Brown, that this event be turned over to them.

This is the United States of America, and there is no one, no group of people, or organization in this country that has the right to censor speech. Under the First Amendment of the US Constitution, there is an inherent right to Free Speech, whether privately or publicly.

In 1991, Pamela Smart was convicted of a crime of which she was not even present. She was moved from NH to NY, for what reason? Fourteen years later a National Cable Network interviews Ms. Smart about her fate. It is interesting that such a small State that never makes the news, with the exception of every four years during the National Election Primary, a murder is reviewed. There is something very wrong about this case. The Warden and the Bedford Correctional Facility probably think that her letter on my site is a threat. They have no idea. It is time to bring out the Microscope to look into what is really going on...
